

A first look at directory submissions services

It had been brought to my attention that a good way to get backward or incoming links is to use a directory submission service. This is where a company most likely not in the US will submit your website to lots of public or free internet directories. The prices range from about \$0.14 to \$0.37 per submission. Has anyone else used these services? Are they worth the money? Here are a few questions that I have:

- Who are some of the more reputable companies making directory submissions?
- Is it possible to do too many submissions to quick?
- Are all of the services submitting to the same open directories?
- How will you know if they made all of the submissions?
- When filling out the form for directory submission how many key words should you use?

Here are some of the directory submission services that I have found so far:

- <http://www.directoriesubmission.com/> these guys charge \$0.37 per submission. I found a coupon wich lowers the price to\$0.30 per submission

- www.articletrader.com This looks like another good potential service. They are essentially\$55 for 150 directories
- <http://www.directorymaximizer.com/> these guys charge \$0.14 per submission. I have signed up for an account but have not paid for any site submission yet. They have 540 directories that they will submit your site to. Also you can set up alternative descriptions for them to use. This domain was purchased in July of 2006. Nameservers are NS1.CHOICEOFHOMES.COM

- <http://www.submit2please.com/> they can do 500 directories for \$99.95 Not to sure about these guys
- <http://www.directoryvault.com/> not to sure about these guys cause they list some online gambling sites These guy give you an excel spreadsheet as a deliverable.
- <http://www.directorystubmission.net/> They have several different programs to choose from. Seems pretty interesting I have decided to go with www.directoriesubmission.com I signed up for 200 submissions and used the Site Point discount code. I submitted Frame Reviews to DirectoriezSubmissions. Currently the home page has a page rank of 2 and no back links. I am curious what it will be like in a few months.
